TEN TIPS FOR READING ALOUD TO A CHILD



Before You READ the Story

- 1. Find a comfortable environment.
- 2. Talk about the cover of the book.
- 3. Discuss what the story might be about.

During the Story

- Use expression; change your voice to fit the mood or action.
- 5. Stop and look at pictures.
- 6. Add information about the story, talk about new words.
- 7. Ask the child to make predictions about the setting, characters or plot.
- 8. Share your thoughts about the story.

After You Read A Story

- 9. Ask the child how they might feel or act if they were one of the characters.
- 10. Encourage the child to share their thoughts about the story or pictures, or relate the story to their own experiences.
